I N F O R M A T I O N

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT ONE

On or about August 15, 1988, in Henry County, in the Western District of Missouri, defendant DUANE JOHN BEAN did willfully injure and commit depredation against property of the United States, that is, property located at Missile Launch Facility G-11 of the United States Air Force, in an amount less than \$100; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1361.

COUNT TWO

On or about August 15, 1988, in Henry County, in the Western District of Missouri, within the jurisdiction of the United States, defendant DUANE JOHN BEAN did enter and go upon Missile Launch Facility G-11, which was part of and under the jurisdiction

States, that is, property located at Missile Launch Facility C-4 of the United States Air Force, in an amount less than \$100; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1361.

COUNT THIRTEEN

On or about August 28, 1988, in Cooper County, in the Western District of Missouri, within the jurisdiction of the United States, defendants BONNIE LEE URFER, KATHLEEN FRANCES KELLY, GAIL BEYER, and DUANE JOHN BEAN did reenter Whiteman Air Force Base property, Missile Launch Facility C-4, after having been ordered not to reenter by the Commanding Officer of Whiteman Air Force Base; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1382.
